a day, several days a week, but return home in the evenings.


A PHP is ideal for individuals who are stable enough to return home in the evening after treatment, but who still require a more intense program. A partial hospitalization program provides similar programs, therapies, and services that come with a residential program, but with the freedom to return home at the end of the day.

A PHP can work in two ways:

- It can be a starting point for individuals who are unable to commit to a residential program
- It can also be a step-down level of care for those coming from a higher level of treatment

### Before You Begin a Florida Partial Hospitalization Program

According to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, Florida saw over 30,000 admissions for substance abuse treatment in 2015 in individuals ages 12 and over.

Many of those who need treatment for substance use disorders never receive help. They might have avoided starting a treatment program because of fears about withdrawal, concerns about the cost, or an unfounded belief that they cannot get better. However, at Beaches Recovery, we're committed to helping our clients build the tools they need for lifelong recovery.

Before addiction treatment can begin, most of those struggling with addiction need to go through some type of drug detox. You can use the services of our partner, Tides Edge Detox Center, for the beginning stages of treatment. After months and possibly years of drinking or using drugs in excess, you become highly dependent on your substance. It takes some time for your body and brain to return to normal.

Once the initial stages of detox are complete, some of the symptoms of withdrawal can linger. These symptoms may include aches, pains, nausea, insomnia, and even severe symptoms like seizures or hallucinations. However, in a partial hospitalization program for addiction treatment, you'll get the care you need while you begin the rehab process.

## Does Your Loved One Need Detox?

#### Understanding Your Options for Levels of Care

Before you can determine if a partial hospitalization program is in your best interest, you must understand the different levels of care that can be part of a comprehensive treatment plan. Make the best decision for your treatment by learning about how detox, outpatient care, and sober living can help you recover. Beaches

Recovery provides the following levels of care:

#### **Detox**

A detox center allows the client to remove the harmful substances from their body. This medically supervised process allows the individual to then continue the rest of their treatment plan with a clear mind. Since they are able to focus on their treatment and not on their cravings, the programs and services tend to be more effective overall.

#### **Inpatient Treatment Programs**

An inpatient program is often the next step for those in need of addiction treatment. This higher level of care allows clients to fully immerse themselves in their plan to gain the most from their time spent at the facility. Here, they participate in a fully scheduled, structured day that includes meetings, therapy sessions, and other activities.

#### **Partial Hospitalization Program**

A PHP can act as either a starting point for those unable to attend inpatient treatment or the next step of a comprehensive treatment plan. Clients will still participate in a highly structured and rigorous day but will have the ability to return home in the evenings.

#### **Intensive Outpatient Treatment Program**

An IOP is another step-down in a more complex treatment plan. During an IOP, clients still return home at the end of their day, but their overall treatment begins to lessen in intensity. The time spent in treatment begins to reduce in comparison to higher-level programs, and clients start to experience slightly more freedom.

#### **Outpatient Treatment Program**

An outpatient program allows clients to begin integrating back home into their normal life. The time required at treatment continues to decrease as clients experience more freedom within their day. This allows them to attend to their daily responsibilities and begin to shape their schedule after treatment.

#### **Sober Living Program**

Sober living after treatment helps provide an additional level of structure and care before clients head home for good. Clients live in a sober living home and participate in meetings, chores, and work towards their goals before returning to their home full time.

#### Benefits of a Partial Hospitalization Program

A PHP offers several benefits for those seeking addiction treatment. For those who are struggling with a less intense substance, a partial hospitalization program in Florida could be the ideal starting point.

Some of the benefits of a partial hospitalization program include:

- High levels of support
- More flexibility than residential care
- Ability to take care of responsibilities at home
- Structure after residential treatment

A PHP allows clients to receive the support they need for recovery, without needing to commit to residential treatment. This is also ideal for those unable to commit to residential care. Instead of being discouraged from seeking out treatment, they are able to participate in a PHP and remain in their home. They can begin treatment, knowing their responsibilities and commitments at home will not be left unattended while they receive the care they need to achieve recovery.

For those ending a residential program, a partial hospitalization program provides another layer of structure before they return home for good. The risk of relapse is greater in those who immediately return straight

home after residential treatment versus those who continue with a plan after they leave the facility.
